



CITATION BY THE STATE OF WISCONSIN

Lublin 700th Anniversary

WHEREAS, The Village of Lublin is located in northcentral Wisconsin in the Town of Roosevelt and has been the proud sister city to Lublin, Poland since March 16, 2001; and

WHEREAS, The Village of Lublin annually hosts Lublin Days festivities where they have welcomed international dignitaries from Europe and established a citizen ambassador exchange program to continue fostering ties between Lublin, Wisconsin and Lublin, Poland; and

WHEREAS, Over the last 17 years the Village of Lublin has hosted citizen ambassadors from abroad and reciprocated that honor with chapter members and supporters traveling to Europe; and

WHEREAS, In 2015, the Village of Lublin celebrated its centennial anniversary and invited dignitaries from Belarus, Lithuania, Poland, and the Ukraine, and during the ceremony the Honorable Andrzej Pruszkowski, Vice Chair of the Lublin Regional Parliament, invited residents from Lublin, Wisconsin to attend the 700 years celebration in Lublin, Poland; and

WHEREAS, Since that time, 35 delegates from the United States, including members from Wisconsin, have assembled to be representatives at the Lublin 700 year ceremonies in August of 2017; now
